#### B2 ENGLISH LANGUAGE EXAM FOR FOREIGNERS RULES & DESCRIPTION

The exam consists of a **written and an oral part** and takes place **remotely on the UPeL platform**.

# A It is absolutely obligatory for the candidate to have a device equipped with a camera, a microphone and a stable access to the Internet (stable Internet connection).

Moreover, the candidate must ensure that no one and nothing disrupts the exam (i.e. eliminate noise, ensure that other people do not interfere during the exam).

#### \* The written part

includes tasks testing grammar, vocabulary, reading comprehension, listening comprehension and one open task - writing.

#### → The duration of the written part is <u>60 minutes</u>.

 $\rightarrow$  The maximum number of <u>points to score is 60</u>.

#### \* The oral part

consists of <u>4 questions</u> from <u>4 different categories</u>:

- 1. General questions,
- 2. Science and work,
- 3. Environment and technology,
- 4. Miscellaneous.
- → Answers should be given based on your knowledge and your own experiences.
- → The system will choose one question from each category.
- → The questions must be answered in the form of a video.
- → The time allowed to answer one question is <u>90 seconds</u>.
- $\rightarrow$  10 points can be scored for each question.
- → The maximum number of points to score for the oral part of the exam is 40.
- ➔ The oral exam is recorded\*.
- → The candidate is obliged to keep the microphone and camera on all the time during the oral part of the exam, has to be visible when answering questions and be in the camera frame continuously.
- → Candidates who fail to meet these requirements do not receive any points i.e. the final score for the oral part is 0%.
- ➔ In order to pass the exam, the candidate is required to obtain min. 50% in the written part and min. 50% in the oral part, i.e. min. 30 points in the written part and min. 20 points in the oral part of the exam, i.e. 50% of the total score.

## → A score of less than 50% in either part of the exam means that the candidate does not receive a pass mark for the exam as a whole.

Information about the exam will also be available on the candidate's individual account in *e-Rekrutacja* system.

We need to obtain a recording containing your image to verify your identity during the exam and to protect against dependence on exam work.

The recording with your image will not be distributed. We will store it for a limited time and only authorized persons will have access to it.
